At some point in 1863, Mark Twain caught a horrible cold. Recounted in his essay *How to Cure A Cold*, Twain describes his travels from Virginia City, Nevada, to Lake Bigler (Tahoe) to Steamboat Hot Springs (between Reno and Carson City) and finally to San Francisco in a desperate attempt to find a sure and speedy cure. 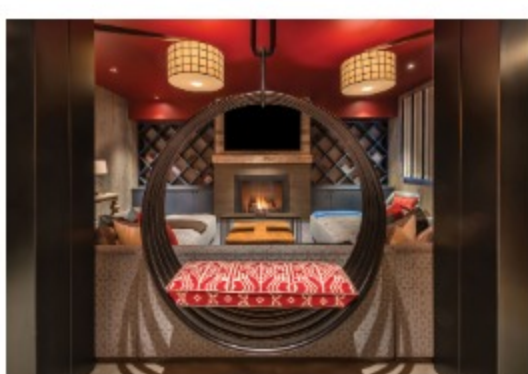

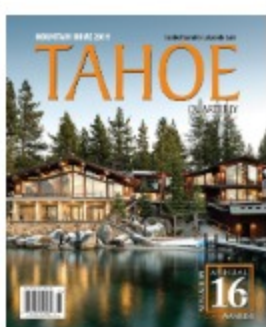

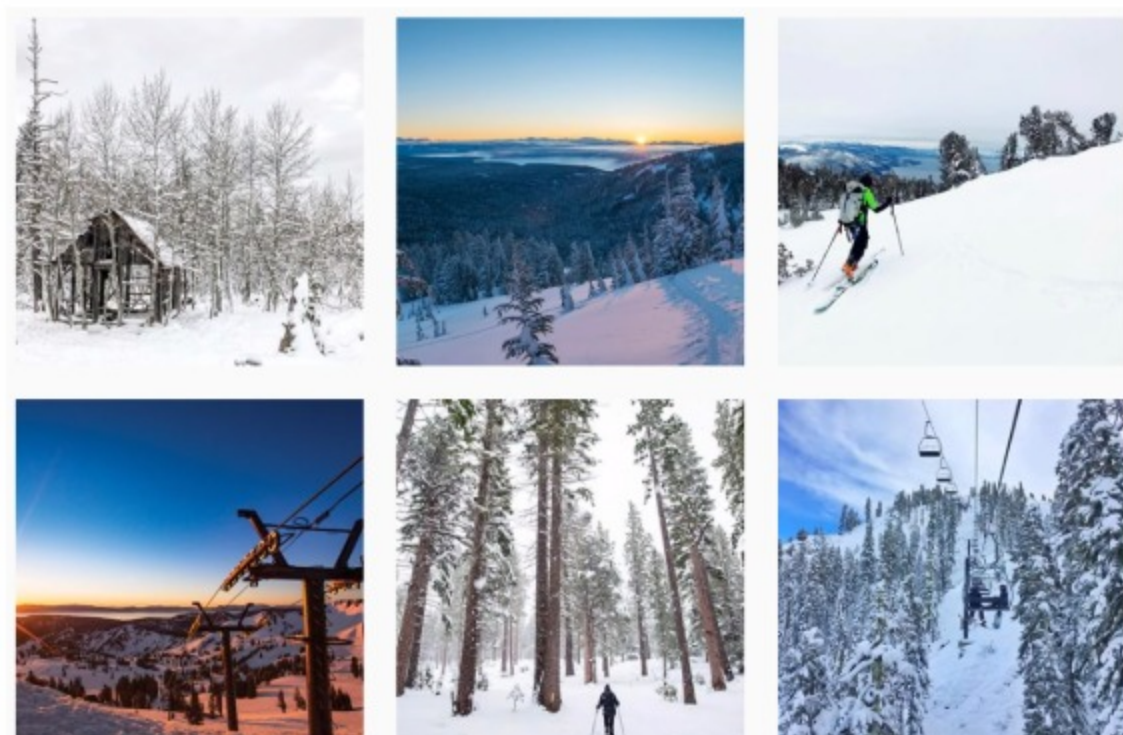
